SPECIAL FIELD RULES
BEAVER BRANCH OIL FIELD
ADAMS and FRANKLIN COUNTIES, MISSISSIPPI

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi on the matter of the adoption and promulgation by the Board of special field rules for the Beaver Branch Field in Adams and Franklin Counties, Mississippi, said hearing being called for such purpose by said Board; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in the manner and way as provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS pursuant to said notice given, a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building at Jackson, Mississippi on December 16, 1959, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all proposed special field rules were presented and fully discussed and duly considered; and

WHEREAS the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and is of the considered opinion that the following special field rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is accordingly hereby ordered by the State Oil and Gas Board that the following special field rules be and the same are hereby adopted by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi for the Beaver Branch Field in Adams and Franklin Counties, Mississippi, to be in effect on and after January 1, 1960, to-wit:

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- A. That the Beaver Branch Field as used herein shall mean that area in Sections 31, 33 and 50, Township 5 North, Range 1 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and in Section 44, Township 5 North, Range 1 East, Franklin County, Mississippi, and including all productive extensions thereof, which area is underlain by any of the hereinafter described pools.
- B. The Minter Sand Oil Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil from the depth of 6647 to 6664 feet (6530 to 6547 feet subsea) on the electric log of the Humble No. 1 Hollinger Well and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.
- C. The Baker Sand Oil Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil from the depths of 6414 to 6433 feet (6292 to 6311 feet subsea) on the electric log of the Serio-Punches No. 1 Hollinger Well and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.
- D. The characteristics of the producing pools in the Beaver Branch Field are such that one well drilled on a regularly formed 40 acre drilling unit will efficiently

drain and produce the recoverable oil from such unit in said pools without avoidable waste.

All rules and regulations contained in the Statewide Order No. 201-51, and amendments thereto, are hereby adopted and shall apply in said field.

The Board expressly reserves its right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
