ORDER NO. 334-68

O R D E R

This day this cause coming on to be heard on the petition of Eugene W. Tynes, of Natchez, Mississippi, requesting the State Oil and Gas Board to amend the Special Field Rules for the Beaver Branch Field, Adams County, Mississippi, so as to identify and define the Walker Sand Oil Pool, the Blaney Sand Oil Pool, the Crosby Sand Oil Pool and the McKittrick Sand Oil Pool in said field, and the Board finding that due and legal notice of the meeting of this Board for the purpose of considering the above petition has been given in the manner and form provided by the rules and regulations of this Board, and that due and proper proofs of all legal and required notices are on file with this Board in said cause; that the Board has full jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter in this cause, and having heard the evidence of witnesses and arguments of counsel and being advised in the premises, is of the opinion that the relief sought in said petition should be granted in the manner and form hereinafter set out.

The Board further finds that by its Order No. 289-59 entered in Docket No. 214-59-102, Special Field Rules for the Beaver Branch Field were adopted, and that said Special Field Rules should now be amended so as to identify and define the Walker Sand Oil Pool, the Blaney Sand Oil Pool, the Crosby Sand Oil Pool and the McKittrick Sand Oil Pool as separate and distinct pools in the Beaver Branch Field, said pools having been encountered in petitioner's wells in said field.

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Special Field Rules for the Beaver Branch Field, Adams and Franklin Counties, Mississippi, be and they are hereby amended so as to identify and define said pools as follows:

"D. The Walker Sand Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata productive of oil occurring in the Wilcox formation between the depths of 6453 feet and 6475 feet subsea as indicated on the Schlumberger Induction Electric Log in the Eugene W. Tynes - USA #6 Well located in Section 31, Township 5 North, Range 1 West, Adams County, Mississippi, or other strata productive of oil correlative to this interval found in other wells.

"E. The Blaney Sand Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata productive of oil occurring in the Wilcox formation between the depths of 6602 feet and 6618 feet subsea as indicated on the Schlumberger Induction Electric Log in the Eugene W. Tynes - USA #7 Well located in Section 31, Township 5 North, Range 1 West, Adams County, Mississippi, or other strata productive of oil correlative to this interval found in other wells.

"F. The Crosby Sand Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata productive of oil occurring in the Wilcox formation between the depths of 6438 feet and 6447 feet subsea as indicated on the Schlumberger Induction Electric Log in the Eugene W. Tynes - USA #5 Well located in Section 31, Township 5 North, Range 1 West, Adams County, Mississippi, or other strata productive of oil correlative to this interval found in other wells.

"G. The McKittrick Sand Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata productive of oil occurring in the Wilcox formation between the depths of 6239 feet and 6253 feet subsea as indicated on the Schlumberger Induction Electric Log in the Eugene W. Tynes - USA #5 Well located in Section 31, Township 5 North, Range 1 West, Adams County, Mississippi, or other strata productive of oil correlative to this interval found in other wells.

"H. The characteristics of the producing pools in the Beaver Branch Field are such that one well drilled on a regularly formed 40-acre drilling unit will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable oil from such unit in said pools without avoidable waste."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that petitioner, Eugene W. Tynes, be and he is hereby authorized to produce and operate his wells completed in the above described oil pools in compliance with the Special Field Rules heretofore adopted by this Board and as amended by this order.
