IN RE: PETITION OF DOUBLE J OPERATING COMPANY, INC., FOR THE ADOPTION OF SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR THE NORTH CYPRESS BAYOU FIELD, ADAMS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

ORDER

This matter came on this day to be heard on the sworn Petition of Double J Operating Company, Inc., requesting the Board to adopt and promulgate Special Field Rules for the North Cypress Bayou Field, Adams County, Mississippi, designating and defining the Ashley Sand Oil Pool, the Freewoods Sand Oil Pool, the Baker Sand Oil Pool, the Jenkins Sand Oil Pool, and the Robinson-Barksdale Sand Oil Pool; and the Board having considered the Petition of Petitioner and exhibit thereto attached and being fully advised in the premises, on evidence adduced, and finding that the Board has complete jurisdiction hereof and that due and legal notice has been published in accordance with the law and the rules and regulations of this Board, the Board is of the opinion that the relief prayed for should be granted, and that the following Special Field Rules should be adopted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following Special Field Rules be, and the same hereby are, adopted by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi for the North Cypress Bayou Field, Adams County, Mississippi, to take effect on and after the 18 day of Acres, 1987, to-wit:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR THE NORTH CYPRESS BAYOU FIELD, ADAMS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

(A)

The North Cypress Bayou Field, as used herein, is that area in Section 1, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Adams County, Mississippi, including all productive extensions thereof underlain by the Ashley Sand Oil Pool, the Freewoods Sand Oil Pool, the Baker Sand Oil Pool, the Jenkins Sand Oil Pool, and the Robinson-Barksdale Sand Oil Pool of the Wilcox Formation.

- 1. The Ashley Sand Oil Pool, as herein used, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from a logged depth of 6,249 feet to 6,256 feet in the Echols-LeBlanc #1-11 Well located in Section 1, T4N-R4W, Adams County, Mississippi, including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.
- 2. The Freewoods Sand Oil Pool, as herein used, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the logged depth of 6,346 feet to 6,356 feet in the Echols-LeBlanc #1-11 Well located in Section 1, T4N-R4W, Adams County, Mississippi, including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.
- 3. The Baker Sand Oil Pool, as herein used, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from a logged depth of 6,712 feet to 6,723 feet in the Echols-LeBlanc #1-11A Well located in Section 1, T4N-R4W, Adams County, Mississippi, including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.
- 4. The Jenkins Sand Oil Pool, as herein used, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from a logged depth of 6,783 feet to 6,790 feet in the Echols-LeBlanc #1-11 Well located in Section 1, T4N-R4W, Adams County, Mississippi, including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.
- 5. The Robinson-Barksdale Sand Oil Pool, as herein used, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from a logged depth of 6,794 feet to 6,846 feet in the Echols-LeBlanc #1-11 Well, located in Section 1, T4N-R4W, Adams County, Mississippi, including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.

(B)

The above described oil pools are separate and

distinct reservoirs, and not in communication with any other reservoir producing formation, pool or horizon.

The characteristics of the above mentioned oil pools are such that one well for such pools drilled in accordance with the statewide rules and regulations will effectively drain and produce the recoverable oil from such unit in said pools without avoidable waste.

RULE 1 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:

- (a) All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.
- (b) The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
