ORDER NO. 399-70

O R D E R

This cause came on for hearing this day before the State Oil and Gas Board on the petition of Pan American Petroleum Corporation, requesting the State Oil and Gas Board to adopt Special Field Rules for the Dollar Lake Field, located in LeFlore County, Mississippi, defining the Hosston "G" Oil Pool and the Hosston "H" Oil Pool and requesting authority to dually complete the Pan American Glen W. Brogden No. 1 Well in said pools; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in accordance with law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that the Board has full jurisdiction of such matter to hear and determine same; and

Pursuant to said notice, a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building; Jackson, Mississippi, commencing on October 21, 1970 at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and the proposed Special Field Rules and dual completion of the Glen W. Brogden No. 1 Well were fully discussed and duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

The Board having fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing, and being of the opinion that the following Special Field Rules should be adopted for Dollar Lake Field, LeFlore County, Mississippi, and that the Pan American Glen W. Brogden No. 1 Well should be dually completed for the prevention of waste and protection of the coequal and correlative rights of all owners in said field;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the following Special Field Rules be and the same are hereby adopted for the Dollar Lake Field located in LeFlore County, Mississippi, to wit:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR THE DOLLAR LAKE FIELD
LEFLORE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

FIELD LIMITS:

The Dollar Lake Field, as used herein, is that portion of Section Twenty-five (25) and Thirty-six (36), located in LeFlore County and Sections Twenty-six (26) and Thirty-five (35) of Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Two (2) West, LeFlore County, Mississippi underlain by the Hosston "G" Oil Pool and the Hosston "H" Oil Pool and all productive extensions thereof as hereinafter defined.

HOSSTON "G" OIL POOL DEFINED:

The Hosston "G" Oil Pool in the Dollar Lake Field is defined as that interval productive of hydrocarbons between 6,527 feet and 6,546 feet by electrical log measurement in the Pan American Petroleum Corp.--Glen W. Brogden No. 1 well located 660 feet South and 557 feet West of the NE corner of the NW quarter of the SE quarter of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Two (2) West, LeFlore County, Mississippi.

HOSSTON "H" OIL POOL DEFINED:

The Hosston "H" Oil Pool in the Dollar Lake Field is defined as that interval productive of hydrocarbons between 6,642 feet and 6,670 feet by electrical log measurement in the Pan American

Petroleum Corp.--Glen W. Brogden No. 1 Well located 660 feet South and 557 feet West of the NE corner of the NW quarter of the SE quarter of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Two (2) West, LeFlore County, Mississippi

RULE-1-APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:

a. All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51 and all amendments thereto are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

b. The Board expressly reserves the right after notice and hearing to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pan American Petroleum Corporation be allowed to dually complete and produce the Pan American Glen W. Brogden No. 1 Well, located in Section Twenty-six (26), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Two (2) West, LeFlore County, Mississippi, in the Hosston "G" Oil Pool and the Hosston "H" Oil Pool as defined herein.
