ORDER NO. 15-86ORDER

This day this cause came on for hearing on the petition of Pruet Production Co., of Jackson, Mississippi, requesting the Board to adopt Special Field Rules for the Glenhaven Field in Monroe County, Mississippi, and the Board finds that due and legal notice of the meeting of this Board has been given in the manner and time required by law and the rules and regulations of this Board and that due and proper proofs of publication are on file with this Board; that the Board has full jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter, and having heard the evidence presented and arguments of counsel, this Board is of the opinion that said petition should be granted.

The Board further finds that petitioner has recently drilled a wildcat well, known as Pruet Production Co. - Walters 1-12 Well No. 1, on a drilling unit described as the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 15 South, Range 17 West, Monroe County, Mississippi, containing 80 acres, more or less, at a location 500 feet from the West line and 2400 feet from the South line of said Section 1. Said well was drilled under Permit No. 57 issued July 22, 1985 to total depth of 3980 feet and encountered gas in commercial quantities from the Lower Carter Sand Gas Pool and the Carter "A" Sand Gas Pool.

The Board further finds that the characteristics of said Lower Carter Gas Pool and Carter "A" Sand Gas Pool are such that one well located on a drilling unit comprised of 320 contiguous surface acres or a governmental half section containing not less than 300 acres or more than 340 acres formed in the manner prescribed in Exhibit "A" hereto will adequately

and efficiently drain and produce the hydrocarbons in said gas pools without avoidable waste.

The Board further finds that the productive area surrounding said well has been named the Glenhaven Field, and it is essential that Special Field Rules for said field be adopted, after notice and hearing, properly defining said producing pools and the area of said field, being all of Section 1, the E½ of Section 2, the NE¼ of Section 11, and the N½ of Section 12, all in Township 15 South, Range 17 West, Monroe County, Mississippi.

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Special Field Rules attached hereto as Exhibit "A" are hereby adopted for the Glenhaven Field in Monroe County, Mississippi.

SPECIAL FIELD RULES
FOR THE GLENHAVEN FIELD
MONROE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

The Glenhaven Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of the following described land, to-wit:

All of Section 1,
The East Half (E½) of Section 2,
The Northeast Quarter (NE¼) of Section 11, and
The North Half (N½) of Section 12,

All in Township 15 South, Range 17 West,
Monroe County, Mississippi,

underlain by the Lower Carter Sand Gas Pool and the Carter "A" Sand Gas Pool, as hereinafter defined, and all productive extensions thereof.

I. The Lower Carter Sand Gas Pool in the Glenhaven Field shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian Formation productive of gas in the interval between the depths of 3,238 feet and 3,288 feet encountered in the Pruet Production Co. - Walters 1-12 Well No. 1, as indicated on the Dual Induction Electric Log of said well, and all sands correlative of these strata productive of gas, said well being located 500 feet from the West line and 2400 feet from the South line of Section 1, Township 15 South, Range 17 West, Monroe County, Mississippi.

II. The Carter "A" Sand Gas Pool in the Glenhaven Field shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian Formation productive of gas in the interval between the depths of 3,218 feet and 3,232 feet encountered in the Pruet Production Co. - Walters 1-12 Well No. 1, as indicated on the Dual Induction Electric Log of said well, and all sands correlative of these strata productive of gas, said well being located 500 feet from the West line and 2400 feet from the South line of Section 1, Township 15 South, Range 17 West, Monroe County, Mississippi.

III. The characteristics of said Lower Carter Sand Gas Pool and Carter "A" Sand Gas Pool of the Mississippian Formation in said field are such that a well located as hereinafter prescribed and drilled upon a drilling unit containing approximately 320 contiguous surface acres or a governmental half section containing not less than 300 acres or more than 340 acres conforming to the requirements of the rules herein contained will adequately and efficiently drain and produce the recoverable gas from such unit in said pools without avoidable waste.

RULE 1 - SPACING OF GAS WELLS:

(a) With respect to each pool, every well drilled as a gas well:

(1) Shall be located on a drilling unit consisting of three hundred twenty (320) contiguous surface acres, or a governmental half section containing not less than 300 acres or more than 340 acres, upon which no other drilling or producible well is located.

(2) Any gas drilling unit not composed of a governmental half section must be completely encompassed by the perimeter of a rectangle 3,735 feet by 5,380 feet. Provided, however, no unit shall be permitted which will create island acreage.

(3) The well shall be located at least 1320 feet from every other drilling or producible well located in conformity with this rule; and

(4) The well shall be located at least 660 feet from every exterior boundary of the drilling unit.

RULE 2 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:

A. All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically

covered by the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

B. The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
