ORDER AMENDING SPECIAL FIELD
RULES OF THE SOUTH LaGRANGE
OIL FIELD TO INCLUDE THE OGDEN
SAND OIL POOL THEREIN AND SET-
TING PRODUCTION ALLOWABLE
THEREFOR.

This day this cause coming on to be heard on the Petition of Natchez Operating Company, Inc., a corporation, for the purpose of amending the Special Field Rules of the South LaGrange Oil Field, (Order No. 138-52 of this Board) to classify and identify the Ogden Sand Oil Pool as a separate pool and to further identify the Parker Sand Oil Pool, and to make said Special Field Rules applicable to the Ogden Sand Oil Pool; and to set a maximum efficient rate of production for said pool and to allocate and apportion such production among the wells completed therein; and to confirm all wells heretofore drilled and completed in said pool, and it appearing unto this Board, and said Board does so find and adjudicate that due, proper and legal notice of this meeting and of the petition filed in this cause has been given in the manner and the form provided by law and the rules and regulations of this Board, and that due and proper proof of all legal and required notices are on file with this Board in this cause, and that this Board has full jurisdiction of this cause, and that petitioner has filed a proper petition, and the Board has heard and considered the same, together with oral and documentary evidence adduced at the hearing and argument of counsel, being fully informed and satisfied that the relief prayed for in said petition should be granted:

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the Ogden Sand Oil Pool, which is now productive in the Natchez Operating Company, Inc. - E. B. Ogden No. 1 Well located approximately 430 feet East and 477 feet South of the Northwest corner of Lot No. 123 of South LaGrange Oil Field, and in

the T. F. Hodge - Ogden Well located on Lot No. 124 of said field is a separate and distinct oil pool completely disconnected from any of the other producing pools or reservoirs in said field.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the title to said Order No. 138-52 be amended and corrected to read as follows:

"SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR PARKER AND OGDEN
SAND OIL POOLS, SOUTH LaGRANGE FIELD,
ADAMS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Rules "A" and "B" contained in said Order No. 138-52 be altered, amended and corrected to read as follows:

"A. The South LaGrange Field, as used herein, is that area in Sections 37, 41, 42, 43, 44, 49, 50 and 51, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including all productive extensions thereof, which area is underlain by the Parker Sand Oil Pool or the Ogden Sand Oil Pool.

"B. The Parker Sand Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil from the depth of 6358 to 6370 feet in the Natchez Operating Company, Inc. - E. B. Ogden No. 2 Well located approximately 330 feet East and 330 feet North of the Southwest corner of Lot No. 123 of the LaGrange Oil Field Area, as depicted on the Map or Plat of Survey and Subdivision of LaGrange Oil Field Area, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, March 1947, by Engineering Service, Jackson, Mississippi, as recorded in Plat Book 3, at page 26; and the South portion thereof re-surveyed by Engineering Service, November 1948, with respect to plantation lines, a Map or Plat of said Survey of the South portion of LaGrange Oil Field Area being recorded in Plat Book 3, page 58, of the records in the office of the Chancery Clerk of Adams County, Mississippi.

The Ogden Sand Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil from the depth of 6384 feet to 6398 feet in the Natchez Operating Company, Inc. - E. B. Ogden No. 1 Well located approximately 430 feet East and 477 feet South of the Northwest corner of the aforesaid Lot No. 123."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the aforesaid Special Field Rules of the South LaGrange Field (Order No. 138-52) are hereby in all particulars made applicable to the Ogden Sand Oil Pool

and all wells heretofore drilled and completed in said pool and the drilling unit upon which same are located are hereby confirmed and validated.

The Board further finds and it is so ordered and adjudged that no necessity exists for fixing of any maximum efficient rate of production or allocation of production from the Ogden Sand Oil Pool.

Said rules as amended to be in full force and effect on and after December 1, 1954, reserving, however, unto all parties the full benefit and protection of any rights accruing to said parties which may have become vested by law in such parties, by reason of said rules.
