O R D E R

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board of the State of Mississippi on the petition of Inexco Oil Company to establish a 640-acre gas unit for its James George No. 2 Well in the Monticello Field, Lawrence County, Mississippi, and for the defining of the Hosston Gas Pool in the Monticello Gas Field; and

The Board finds that proper and legal notice of the meeting for the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matters was given in the manner provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board; and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine the same; and

Pursuant to said notice so given, public hearing was heard by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, North West Street, Jackson, Mississippi, commencing on July 21, 1976, at which meeting all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard; and all testimony and evidence were duly considered by those present at said meeting; and the Board has considered said matter and the evidence and the recommendations made in said hearing and finds as follows:

1. Inexco Oil Company, as Operator, has drilled its James George No. 2 Well on an 80-acre unit in Section 14 of Township 7 North, Range 21

West, Lawrence County, Mississippi, covering the following described land:

From the Southeast Corner of Section 14, T 7 N, R 21 W, Lawrence County, Mississippi, run thence Westerly along the South line of said Section 14 for 2640.0 feet to a point, said point hereinafter referred to as the point of beginning.

Thence Northerly and perpendicular to the South line of said Section 14 for 2640.0 feet;

Thence Easterly and parallel to the South line of said Section 14 for 1098.0 feet, more or less, to the centerline of the Pearl River;

Thence Southeasterly along the centerline of said river for 334.9 feet, more or less;

Thence Southerly and perpendicular to the South line of said Section 14 for 2406.0 feet, more or less;

Thence Westerly along the South line of Section 14 for 1331.7 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

The above described tract is situated in Section 14, T 7 N, R 21 W, Lawrence County, Mississippi, and does contain 80.0 acres.

as a wildcat well under Permit No. 189 issued on October 23, 1975 by this Board; that said well was drilled to a depth below 15,000 feet and encountered in the Hosston Formation intervals capable of producing gas; that the unit for said well should be reformed to conform with Rule 8, as amended in Docket No. 131-69, Order No. 244-69, of this Board; and Inexco Oil Company has proposed a 640-acre gas unit comprising the following described land in Lawrence County, Mississippi, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 14, Township 7 North, Range 21 West, Lawrence County, Mississippi, run thence north along the west boundary of said Section 14, 5,280 feet, run thence in an easterly direction 5,280 feet so as to parallel the south line of said Section 14, run thence in a southerly direction 5,280 feet so as to parallel the west boundary of said Section 14, run thence west along the south boundary of Section 14, 5,280 feet to point of beginning, said lands containing 640 acres, and being located in Section 14 of Township 7 North, Range 21 West, and in Section 15 of Township 7 North, Range 11 East.

2. That the Inexco Oil Company No. 2 James George Well was drilled at a location 2100 feet west of the east line and 2100 feet north of the south line of Section 14, Township 7 North, Range 21 West, and said proposed unit complies with the rules and regulations of this Board.

3. That the field in which the Inexco Oil Company No. 2 James George Well is located has been named by this Board as the Monticello Field, and the Hosston Gas Pool encountered in said field should be defined as:

The Hosston Gas Pool is defined as those strata productive of gas within the interval of 15495 to 16782 feet as shown in the Dual-Induction log of the Inexco Oil Company No. 2 James George Well located 2100 feet from the East line and 2100 feet from the South line of Section 14, Township 7 North, Range 21 West, Lawrence County, Mississippi, and all intervals correlative to or connected with these strata.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the following described land in Lawrence County, Mississippi, is hereby established as the unit for the Inexco Oil Company No. 2 James George Well, said unit being as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 14, Township 7 North, Range 21 West, Lawrence County, Mississippi, run thence north along the west boundary of said Section 14, 5,280 feet, run thence in an easterly direction 5,280 feet so as to parallel the south line of said Section 14, run thence in a southerly direction 5,280 feet so as to parallel the west boundary of said Section 14, run thence west along the south boundary of Section 14, 5,280 feet to point of beginning, said lands containing 640 acres, and being located in Section 14 of Township 7 North, Range 21 West, and in Section 15 of Township 7 North, Range 11 East.

and the Hosston Gas Pool encountered in said field is defined as:

The Hosston Gas Pool is defined as those strata productive of gas within the interval of 15495 to 16782 feet as shown in the Dual-Induction log of the Inexco Oil Company No. 2 James George Well located 2100 feet from the East line and 2100 feet from the South line of Section 14, Township 7 North, Range 21 West, Lawrence County, Mississippi, and all intervals correlative to or connected with these strata.
