O R D E R

This day this cause came on to be heard at the regular July 16, 1980, meeting of the State Oil and Gas Board, upon the petition of Inexco Oil Company to reform a 640-acre gas unit to its Homer Brown No. 1 Well consisting of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, Jones County, Mississippi, to an oil unit consisting of the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, First District, Jones County, Mississippi, and the approval of the location of the said Homer Brown No. 1 Well as an exception to Statewide Rule 7, and for a definition of the Rodessa Pool for the field in which said well is located, and a definition of the Hosston Pool in the field in which said well is located.

The State Oil and Gas Board finds that due and legal notices of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering the above petition were given in the manner and form provided by law and the rules and regulations of this Board, and that due and proper proofs of all legal and required notices are on file with the Board in this cause, and the Board has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter and the right to hear the cause and determine the same at this meeting of the Board, and the Board having heard the evidence of the witnesses, both oral and documentary, finds that the petitioner is entitled to the requested relief, as hereinafter set forth.

The Board finds that the petitioner drilled its Homer Brown No. 1 unit under Permit 591, approved March 31, 1980, as a wildcat gas well on a unit consisting of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, Jones

County, Mississippi, and that in the drilling of said well, instead of encountering gas as anticipated, said well encountered oil at a depth below 12,000 feet, and the petitioner asks that the gas unit be reformed into an oil unit composed of the W½ of the NE¼ of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, Jones County, Mississippi, and that the location of said well, which was 1555 feet west of the east line and 2317 feet south of the north line of the said Section 8, be approved as an exception location under Statewide Rule 7, in that on an oil unit covering the W½ of the NE¼ of said Section 8, the well location will be 323 feet north of the south line and 235 feet west of the east line of the said W½ of the NE¼ of the said Section 8, but will otherwise comply with Rule 7, as amended.

The Board further finds that the Rodessa Gas Pool in the field where the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well was drilled has not been heretofore defined, nor has the Hosston Oil Pool for said field been heretofore defined, and that the field in which the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well is located, the Rodessa Oil Pool therein as encountered in the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well should be defined as:

"The Rodessa Pool is defined as those strata productive of hydrocarbons within the interval of 12,810 feet to 13,392 feet as shown on the Dual-Induction lateral log on the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well located 2317 feet from the north line and 1555 feet from the east line of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, Jones County, Mississippi, and all intervals correlative to or connected with those strata";

and that the Hosston Oil Pool in said field as encountered in said well should be defined as:

"The Hosston Pool is defined as those strata productive of hydrocarbons within the interval of 13,767 feet to 14,035 feet as shown on the Dual-Induction lateral log on the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well located

2317 feet from the north line and 1555 feet from the east line of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, Jones County, Mississippi, and all intervals correlative to or connected with those strata."

It further appearing to the Board that in excess of twelve acres in the above described oil unit is underlain by hydrocarbons in the Rodessa Oil Pool, as hereinabove defined, and in excess of twelve acres of said oil unit is underlain by hydrocarbons in the Hosston Oil Pool, as hereinabove defined, and that said well on said unit should be allowed a full allowable from both pools.

It further appearing to the Board that the reformation of the original unit to an oil unit consisting of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West will protect the co-equal and correlative rights of all parties in interest, and will prevent waste and the drilling of unnecessary wells.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. That the 640-acre gas unit for the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well, as established under Docket No. 65-80, Order No. 92-80, covering Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, is reformed to an oil unit for said well covering the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West.

2. That the location of the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well located on said unit at 323 feet north of the south line and 235 feet west of the east line of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West as an exception to Statewide Rule 7, as amended, is hereby approved, and said well is hereby allotted full allowable from both oil pools, as hereinafter defined.

3. That the Rodessa Oil Pool in the field in which the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well was drilled is defined as follows:

"The Rodessa Pool is defined as those strata productive of hydrocarbons within the interval of 12,810 feet to 13,392 feet as shown on the Dual-Induction lateral log on the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well located 2317 feet from the north line and 1555 feet from

the east line of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, Jones County, Mississippi, and all intervals correlative to or connected with those strata."

4. That the Hosston Oil Pool in said field is hereby defined as follows:

"The Hosston Pool is defined as those strata productive of hydrocarbons within the interval of 13,767 feet to 14,035 feet as shown on the Dual-Induction lateral log on the Inexco Oil Company - Homer Brown No. 1 Well located 2317 feet from the north line and 1555 feet from the east line of Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, Jones County, Mississippi, and all intervals correlative to or connected with those strata."
