COMPANY TO AMEND THE SPECIAL FIELD RULES
FOR THE POPLAR GROVE FIELD, IN ADAMS
COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

O R D E R

This matter came on to be heard on the sworn Petition of Meason Operating Company, requesting the Board to amend the Special Field Rules for the Poplar Grove Field, Adams County, Mississippi, and to define and designate the Minter Sand Oil Pool in the said Field, and the Board, after considering the Application, the evidence given and introduced at the hearing hereof, and the argument of counsel, and therefore being fully advised in the premises, does find as follows:

(1)

That due, proper, and legal notice of the hearing of this matter has been given in the manner and form, and for the time required by Law and the Rules and Regulations of this Board, that due and proper Proofs of Publication of said Notice of Hearing are on file with the Board, and that the Board has full and complete jurisdiction of the matters and parties involved.

(2)

That Meason Operating Company is the Operator of certain wells producing in the Poplar Grove Field, Adams County, Mississippi. That the Poplar Grove Field, as referred to herein, is the subject of Special Field Rules adopted by this Board in Order No. 118-56, approved May 16, 1956. That in the said

Special Field Rules, the Poplar Grove Field was defined as that area in Sections 29, and 45, T6N-R2W, Adams County, Mississippi, and including all productive extensions thereof, which area is underlain by the Baker Sand Oil Pool and the Benbrook-Ratcliff Sand Oil Pool, as said pools were defined in the above referred to Order. That since the adoption of the above described Order, the Emery Unit E-1 has been drilled and has obtained production in an additional oil pool in the Poplar Grove Field which is a separate and distinct reservoir not in communication with any other producing formation, pool or horizon. That the Meason Operating-Emery E-1 unit is presently in production from the Minter Sand Oil Pool of the Wilcox Formation as hereinafter defined.

(3)

That the above referred to Special Field Rules should be amended so as to designate and define the Minter Sand Oil Pool presently in production, said pool being defined as follows, to-wit:

The Minter Sand Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the depth of 6582' to 6588', in the Meason Operating Company-Emery E-1 Unit, located in Section 45, T6N-R2W, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith. The well location for the Emery E-1 Unit is as follows:

From the Southeast corner of Section 45, T6N-R2W, Adams County, Mississippi, go North along the East boundary of Section 45 for 1538 feet; thence West at right angles for 453 feet to location in Section 45.

(4)

That the above described oil pool is a separate and distinct reservoir and not in communication with any other reservoir or producing formation, pool or horizon.

(5)

That in all other respects, except as herein expressly amended, the Special Field Rules for the Poplar Grove Field should be continued in full force and effect.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Special Field Rules, for the Poplar Grove Field, Adams County, Mississippi, be, and the same hereby are, amended for the purpose of defining and designating the Minter Sand Oil Pool in the said Field.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Special Field Rules for the Poplar Grove Field, continue in full force and effect except as herein expressly amended.
