O R D E R

THIS DAY this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the Petition of Howard Berry for the adoption of Special Field Rules for the Reid Field, Calhoun County, Mississippi, defining the Abernathy Gas Pool and providing for 640-acre units, such hearing being called for such purpose; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter was given in the manner and way provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine the same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice given public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, North West Street, Jackson, Mississippi, commencing on December 19, 1973, at which hearing all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all testimony and evidence were duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and finds that Special Field Rules should be adopted;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Special Field Rules for Reid Field, Calhoun County, Mississippi, be adopted as follows:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES
REID FIELD
CALHOUN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Reid Field as used herein is that area defined as follows:

E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 21, Section 22, Section 23, Section 26, Section 27, and the N 1/2 of NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 of Section 35, all in Township 12 South, Range 1 East, Calhoun County, Mississippi, underlain by the Abernathy Gas Pool and all productive extensions thereof.

B. The Abernathy Gas Pool as used herein shall mean those strata of the Mississippian Formation productive of gas from the interval between 3360 feet and 3450 feet on the electric log of the Pan American-E. L. Bruce Well No. A-1 located in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 26, Township 12 South, Range 1 East, Calhoun County, Mississippi.

C. The characteristics of the Abernathy Gas Pool are such that wells located in conformance with Rule 8.1. of the Statewide Rules and Regulations will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable gas from said pool without avoidable waste.

RULE 1 - SPACING:

Wells drilled to and produced from the Abernathy Gas Pool shall be located on 640-acre units as prescribed

by Rule 8.1. of the Statewide Rules and Regulations.

RULE 2 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:

(a) All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

(b) The Board expressly reserves the right after notice and hearing to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
