ORDER

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the matter of the adoption and promulgation by the Board of special field rules for the Roxie Oil Field in Franklin County, Mississippi, said hearing being called for such purpose by said Board; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in the manner and way as provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS pursuant to said notice given a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk Office Building at Jackson, Mississippi, on October 16, 1963, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matters were heard and all proposed special field rules were fully discussed and duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and is of the opinion that the following special field rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field;

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED by the State Oil and Gas Board that the following special field rules be and the same are hereby adopted by the

State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi for the Roxie Oil Field located in Franklin County, Mississippi, to take effect on and after November 1, 1963, to-wit:

**SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR ROXIE FIELD
IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI**

A. That the Roxie Field as used herein is that area in Sections 28 and 29, Township 6 North, Range 2 East, Franklin County, Mississippi, including all extensions thereof, underlain by any of the Wilcox Sand Pools hereinafter described:

1. The Benbrook Producing Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the depths of 6127 feet to 6146 feet in the Joseph F. Francis USA Well No. C-1 located approximately 2316 feet from South line and 2920 feet from West line of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 2 East, Franklin County, Mississippi; and those strata which may be correlated therewith.

2. The McKittrick Producing Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the depths of 6056 feet to 6068 feet in the Joseph F. Francis and Biglane Operating Company USA #C-3 Well located approximately 1560 feet South and 630 feet East of the center of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 2 East, Franklin County, Mississippi; and those strata which may be correlated therewith.

3. The Armstrong Producing Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the depths of 6139 feet to 6148 feet in the W. K. Griffin, Jr. and Kelley and Byrne - Boyte, et al, Well No. 2 located approximately 50 feet from South line and 50 feet from East line of SW -1/4 of NW -1/4 of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 2 East, Franklin County, Mississippi, and those strata which may be correlated therewith.

B. The characteristics of the producing pools in the Roxie Field are such and evidence shows that one well drilled on a regularly formed 40-acre drilling unit will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable oil from such unit in said pools without avoidable waste.

SPACING

RULE I All existing producing units and well locations are hereby approved.

RULE II No well shall be drilled less than 100 feet from any other well regardless of the pool from which it is producing.

RULE III

All rules and regulations contained in the Statewide Order No. 201-51 and amendments thereto not specifically covered in the foregoing rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.
