In the matter of the Petition of Kelley & Byrne Oil Co. and Trio Operating Co., Inc. for the Adoption of Special Field Rules in the Southwood Field, Adams County, Mississippi

ORDER NO. 215-66

This day this cause coming on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi upon the duly verified petition of Kelley & Byrne Oil Co. and Trio Operating Co., Inc. for the adoption of special field rules in the Southwood Field, Adams County, Mississippi, including all extensions thereof underlain by any of the Wilcox sand pools which are hereinafter described. The petitioners are the duly appointed, designated and acting operators of the oil and gas lease and/or leases covering a part of the Southwood Field, which is the subject matter of their petition and particularly the lands and units assigned to the Kelley & Byrne Oil Co. - Newman Central No. 1 well, located and being in the Southwood Field, Adams County, Mississippi.

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of this Board for the purpose of considering the petition of Kelley & Byrne Oil Co. and Trio Operating Co., Inc. for the adoption of special field rules for the Southwood Field, Adams County, Mississippi, has been given in the manner and form provided by law and the regulations and rules

of this Board, and the proofs of the giving of such notice are on file with this Board, and that this Board has full jurisdiction of this cause and of the parties and the right to hear this cause and determine the same at this meeting; and,

The petitioners having filed a proper verified petition for the adoption of special field rules in the Southwood Field in Adams County, Mississippi; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice given a public hearing was held by this Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk Office Building in Jackson, Mississippi, on August 17, 1966, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matters were heard and all proposed special field rules were fully discussed and duly considered by those present at said meeting; and,

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence taken and adduced at said hearing and is of the opinion that the following special field rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field;

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED by the Mississippi State Oil and Gas Board that the following special field rules be and the same are hereby adopted by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi for the Southwood Field located in Adams County, Mississippi, to take effect on and after September 1, 1966, to-wit:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR SOUTHWOOD FIELD
ADAMS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

The Southwood Field as used herein is defined as that area located in Sections 45 and 46, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, including all extensions thereof, underlain by any of the Wilcox Sand Pools hereinafter described.

(A) The McKittrick Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil between the depths of 6324 feet and 6344 feet in the Kelley & Byrne Oil Co. - Newman Central No. 1, located in Section 46, T6N - R2W, which is located from the southwest corner of Section 45 go easterly along line 2130 feet; thence southerly at right angles 1410 feet to location in Section 46, discovery well of Southwood Field, and all those strata which may be correlated therewith.

(B) The Benbrook Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil between the depths of 6370 feet and 6390 feet in the Kelley & Byrne Oil Co. - Newman Central No. 1, located in Section 46, T6N-R2W, which is located from the southwest corner of Section 45 go easterly along line 2130 feet; thence southerly at right angles 1410 feet to location in Section 46, discovery well of Southwood Field, and all those strata which may be correlated therewith.

(C) The Baker Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil between the depths of 6394 feet and 6420 feet in the Kelley & Byrne Oil Co. - Newman Central No. 1, located in Section 46, T6N-R2W, which is located from the southwest corner of Section 45 go easterly along line 2130 feet; thence southerly at right angles 1410 feet to location in Section 46, discovery well of Southwood Field, and all those strata which may be correlated therewith.


(D) The Jenkins Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil between the depths of 6480 feet and 6490 feet in the Kelley & Byrne Oil Co. - Newman Central No. 1, located in Section 46, T6N-R2W, which is located from the southwest corner of Section 45 go easterly along line 2130 feet; thence southerly at right angles 1410 feet to location in Section 46, discovery well of Southwood Field, and all those strata which may be correlated therewith.

SPACING RULES

- Rule I All existing producing units and well locations are hereby approved.
- Rule II No well shall be drilled less than 100 feet from any other well regardless of the pool from which it is producing.
- Rule III All rules and regulations contained in the State-wide Order No. 201-51 and amendments thereto not specifically covered in the foregoing rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said Field.
