ORDER

This cause came on this day for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the petition of PAN AMERICAN PETROLEUM CORPORATION requesting that the Board amend Special Field Rules for the Stamps Field, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, so as to define the Barksdale Oil Sand.

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in accordance with law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that the Board has jurisdiction of the subject matter; and

After public hearing held by the Board in the Woolfork State Office Building, Jackson, Mississippi, on March 18, 1970, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard were heard and all evidence received; and the Board, having fully considered the evidence and recommendations presented, being of the opinion that the relief sought by the Petitioner should be granted;

IT IS, THEREFORE, Ordered by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the relief sought by the Petitioner be granted and that the Special Field Rules for the Stamps Field, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, be amended so as to add to Paragraph A of said Special Field Rules the following definition:

The Barksdale Oil Sand, as used herein, shall be construed and defined to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil identified by electrical log measurement from the depth of 7,990 feet to 8,016 feet in the W. H. Pritchardt "A" #1 Well located 3,753 feet from the South line and 657 feet from the West line, Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 5 West, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.
