ORDER AMENDING SPECIAL FIELD RULES

THIS DAY this matter came on for hearing on the Petition of Grace Petroleum Corporation, asking that the Special Field Rules for the Stinson Creek Field be amended, and the Board being fully advised, does find as follows:

1.

Proper, due and legal notice for the meeting of this Board to consider this Petition has been given as required by law and the rules of this Board, and due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication of notice are on file with this Board. The Board does further adjudicate that it has full and complete jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine this Petition at this time and place.

2.

Grace Petroleum Corporation has drilled its Cungious 9-15 Well located in the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 18 West, Lowndes County, Mississippi. The well has encountered two gas pools, neither of which has been previously defined. Said new pools, namely the Nason Sand Gas Pool and the Sanders Sand Gas Pool should be defined in the Special Field Rules for the Stinson Creek Field. Further, it appears that said gas pools extend into Section 16 and the W 1/2 of Section 15, Township 17 South, Range 18 West, Lowndes County, Mississippi. Accordingly, it is appropriate to amend the Special Field Rules for the Stinson Creek Field

to define said pools and to include said Section 16 and the W 1/2 of Section 15. In a companion docket, Grace has amended the Special Field Rules of the Wells Field to remove said Section 16 and the W 1/2 of Section 15 from the geographical limits of said field.

3.

The amended Special Field Rules are set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

4.

The amendment to the Special Field Rules will allow for and will promote the proper and orderly development of the Wells Field and will not interfere with the development of the Stinson Creek Field, will prevent waste, and will protect the coequal and correlative rights of all the owners in said Wells Field and the Stinson Creek Field.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Special Field Rules for the Stinson Creek Field be, and they are hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that permittee shall acquire all other permits, if any, by any other permitting authority.

EXHIBIT "A"

SPECIAL FIELD RULES  
STINSON CREEK FIELD, LOWNDES COUNTY

A. FIELD AREA:

The Stinson Creek Field, as used herein, is that geographical area consisting of the following described lands, and including all productive extensions thereof, to-wit:

Section 4:	ALL
Section 5:	ALL
Section 6:	ALL
Section 7:	ALL
Section 8:	ALL
Section 9:	ALL
Section 15:	W 1/2
Section 16:	ALL

Township 17 South, Range 18 West,  
Lowndes County, Mississippi

B. POOL DEFINITIONS:

1.1 The Upper Carter Sand Gas Pool in the Stinson Creek Field shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian Formation productive of hydrocarbons occurring between the measured depths of 5120 feet to 5156 feet on the dual induction focus log of the Pruet Production Co., et al - Newman 4-3 Well No. 1 located in Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 18 West, Lowndes County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of hydrocarbons which can be correlated therewith and are in communication therewith.

1.2 The Lewis Sand Gas Pool in the Stinson Creek Field shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian Formation productive of hydrocarbons occurring between the measured depths of 5784 feet to 5804 feet on the dual induction focus log of the Pruet Production Co., et al - Newman 4-3 Well No. 1 located in Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 18 West, Lowndes County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of

hydrocarbons which can be correlated therewith and are in communication therewith.

1.3 The Nason Sand Gas Pool in the Stinson Creek Field shall be construed to mean those strata productive of hydrocarbons occurring between the gross interval of 2594 feet and 2823 feet on the dual induction focus log of the Grace-Cungious 9-15 Well located 1300 feet from the South line and 1500 feet from the East line of Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 18 West, and including those strata productive of hydrocarbons which can be correlated therewith and are in communication therewith.

1.4 The Sanders Sand Gas Pool in the Stinson Creek Field shall be construed to mean those strata productive of hydrocarbons occurring between the gross interval of 5210 feet and 5430 feet on the dual induction focus log of the Grace-Cungious 9-15 Well located 1300 feet from the South line and 1500 feet from the East line of Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 18 West, and including those strata productive of hydrocarbons which can be correlated therewith and are in communication therewith.

C. RULES:

RULE 1 - SPACING OF GAS WELLS:

1.1 As to each well drilled to a productive zone in the Upper Carter Sand Gas Pool, the Lewis Sand Gas Pool, the Nason Sand Gas Pool or the Sanders Sand Gas Pool:

(a) The well shall be located on a drilling unit consisting of 320 contiguous surface acres, or a governmental half section containing not less than 300 acres or more than 340, or 8 contiguous governmental quarter-quarter sections whose total acreage is not less than 300 or more than 340 acres. In any case, no other well producing from the same pool shall be located on any such unit.

(b) Any gas drilling unit formed under this section must be completely encompassed by the perimeter of a rectangle 3735 feet by 5380 feet. Provided, however, no unit shall be permitted

which will create island acreage.

(c) The well shall be located at least 1320 feet from every other drilling well or well completed in or producing from the same pool located in conformity with this rule.

(d) The well shall be located not less than 660 feet from every exterior boundary of the unit.

RULE 2 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:

2.1 All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

2.2 The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing Special Field Rules, or to grant exceptions to all or any part thereof.
