ORDER

THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the Petition of Renaissance Petroleum Company, LLC to amend the Special Field Rules for Waldrup Field, such hearing being called for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter was given in the manner and way provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board; that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication and service are on file with the Board; and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the Board in the hearing room, Suite E, 500 Greymont Avenue, Jackson, Mississippi, commencing on Wednesday, March 20, 2013, and the Board heard testimony and evidence regarding the request by Renaissance Petroleum Company, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and finds as follows:

1. By Order No. 890-2012, Docket No. 495-2012-D, effective December 19, 2012, this Board established Special Field Rules for Waldrup Field. In addition to defining the geographical limits of said Field, said rules define the Cotton Valley Oil Pool, by reference to the array induction log for the Renaissance-Anderson-Tully 12-7 No. 1 Well with 160 acre spacing for all wells drilled to and completed in said defined pool.

2. By Order No. 38-2013, Docket No. 18-2013-D, effective January 16, 2013, Petitioner was granted authority to reform the 160 acre drilling unit for its Anderson-Tully 12-7 No. 1 Well to an exception 240 acre production unit for production and further development of the Cotton Valley Oil Pool. Production tests have shown that the Anderson-Tully 12-7 No. 1 Well will effectively drain more than 160 acres from the Cotton Valley Oil Pool and a 240 acre unit will better foster, encourage and promote the development, production and utilization of the

natural resources to be produced from this pool. Petitioner believes that 240 acre spacing should be established for the Cotton Valley Oil Pool.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Special Field Rules of Waldrup Field, Jasper County, Mississippi shall be and are hereby amended to read as follows:

**SPECIAL FIELD RULES
WALDRUP FIELD
JASPER COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI**

FIELD LIMITS:

The Waldrup Field is defined as that area consisting of the following described lands:

JASPER COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

Township 1 North, Range 11 East

Section 1: SW 1/4
Section 2: SE 1/4
Section 11: NE 1/4
Section 12: N 1/2

Township 1 North, Range 12 East

Section 7: NW 1/4

And all productive extensions thereof.

COTTON VALLEY OIL POOL DEFINED:

The Cotton Valley Oil Pool in Waldrup Field is defined as those strata of the Cotton Valley Sand productive of oil in the interval between 15,510'-15,522' as indicated on the array induction log for the Renaissance-Anderson-Tully 12-7 #1 Well, located in the center of the North Half of Section 12, Township 1 North, Range 11 East, Jasper County, Mississippi, and all intervals correlative to and/or connected with said strata.

RULE 1: SPACING OF OIL WELLS:

As to each well drilled to and completed in the Cotton Valley Oil Pool:

- (a) Shall be located on a drilling unit consisting of (1) 240 contiguous surface acres; or (2) a governmental Quarter-section containing not less than 216 acres or more than 264 acres; or (3) Six (6) contiguous governmental quarter-quarter sections whose total acreage is not less than 216 or more than 264 acres. In any case, no other well producing from the same pool shall be located on any such unit. The word "contiguous" as used herein shall mean bordering each other at more than one point.

- (b) The well shall be located at least 1,830 feet from every other drilling well or well completed in or producing from the same pool located in conformity with this rule;
- (c) The well shall be located not less than 1100 feet from every exterior boundary of the drilling unit; and
- (d) No unit shall be permitted which will create island acreage.

RULE 2 – APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:

(a) All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and all amendments thereto, not specifically covered by the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

(b) The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
