THIS MATTER came on for hearing upon the petition of Grace Petroleum Corporation, asking that Special Field Rules for Walker Lake Field be adopted, and the Board, being fully advised, does find as follows:

1.

Proper, due and legal notice for the meeting of this Board to consider this application has been given as required by law and the rules of this Board and the due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication of notice are on file with this Board. The Board does further adjudicate that it has full and complete jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine this application at this time and place.

2.

Grace Petroleum Corporation has drilled the Grace Petroleum Corporation - Simmons 17-5 Well No. 1 and has encountered the Lewis Sand Gas Pool for which it is now seeking an NGPA classification. Therefore, Special Field Rules should be adopted for Walker Lake Field. Said Special Field Rules should be defined as follows:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR WALKER LAKE FIELD,
CLAY COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Walker Lake Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of the following described land as underlain by the Lewis Sand Gas Pool and all productive extensions thereof:

CLAY COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

Sections 17, 18, 7 and 8, Township 17
South, Range 6 East, Clay County,
Mississippi.

B. The Lewis Sand Gas Pool of the Walker Lake Field shall be considered those strata productive of gas and condensate in the interval between the depth of 9,430 feet and 9,458 feet as indicated on the Dual Induction Log of the Grace Petroleum Corporation - Simmons 17-5 Well No. 1, located in the W/2 of Section 17 and the E/2 of Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 6 East, Clay County, Mississippi, and all correlative intervals in communication therewith.

Rule 1 - Applicability of Statewide Rules

All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order 201-51, and all effective amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules for Walker Lake Field, are hereby adopted and shall apply to this field.

The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend, or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Special Field Rules for Walker Lake Field, Clay County, Mississippi, be adopted as hereinabove set forth.
