O R D E R

This cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the petition of Pan American Petroleum Corporation requesting the State Oil and Gas Board to define the Cotton Valley 12,611 Oil Pool and the Cotton Valley 12,918 Oil Pool in the Pan American - C. L. Herron No. 1 Well located in Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 6 West, Winchester Field, Wayne County, Mississippi, and requesting authority to dually complete said well in said pools; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in accordance with law and the rules and regulations of the Board and that the Board has jurisdiction of the subject matter, and pursuant to said notice a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, Jackson, Mississippi, on May 21, 1969, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and the Board having fully considered the evidence and recommendations presented being of the opinion that the relief sought by Petitioner should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, Ordered by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the relief sought by Petitioner be granted and that Pan American Petroleum Corporation be allowed to dually complete and produce the Pan American - C. L. Herron No. 1 Well located in

Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 6 West, Winchester Field, Wayne County, Mississippi, in the Cotton Valley 12,611 (perforations 12,611-625 feet) and Cotton Valley 12,918 (perforations 12,987-13,015 feet) Oil Pools as defined herein.

COTTON VALLEY 12,611 DEFINED:

The Cotton Valley 12,611 Oil Pool is defined as that interval productive of hydrocarbons between 12,611 feet and 12,628 feet by electrical log measurement in the Pan American - C. L. Herron No. 1 Well located 330 feet South of the North line and 330 feet West of the East line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 6 West, Winchester Field, Wayne County, Mississippi, and all productive extensions thereof.

COTTON VALLEY 12,918 DEFINED:

The Cotton Valley 12,918 Oil Pool is defined as that interval productive of hydrocarbons between 12,918 feet and 13,040 feet by electrical log measurement in the Pan American - C. L. Herron No. 1 Well located 330 feet South of the North line and 330 feet West of the East line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 6 West, Winchester Field, Wayne County, Mississippi, and all productive extensions thereof.
