PETITION OF SANDEFER OIL & GAS, INC. TO ADOPT SPECIAL
FIELD RULES FOR THE SMACKOVER OIL POOL IN THE SOUTH
WOLF CREEK FIELD, WAYNE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

ORDER

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the matter of the adoption and promulgation of Special Field Rules for the South Wolf Creek Field located in Wayne County, Mississippi; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has given in the manner and way as provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board, and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

Pursuant to said notice a public hearing was held by said Board in the Walter Sillers State Office Building, 550 High Street, Jackson, Mississippi, on October 15, 1986, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matters were heard and all proposed Special Field Rules were fully discussed and duly considered by those persons at said meeting; and

The Board having fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing, is of the opinion that the following Special Field Rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the following Special Field Rules be and the same are hereby adopted for the South Wolf Creek Field located in Wayne County, Mississippi, to take effect on and after October 15, 1986, to-wit:

**SPECIAL FIELD RULES
FOR THE SOUTH WOLF CREEK FIELD
WAYNE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI**

A. FIELD AREA:

The South Wolf Creek Field, as used herein, is that geographical area consisting of the following described lands, to-wit:

Wayne County, Mississippi
Township 10 North, Range 8 West

Section 26: Southeast Quarter, East One-half of the Southwest Quarter, Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and South One-half of the Northeast Quarter (SE/4, E/2 SW/4, SE/4 NW/4 and S/2 NE/4)

Section 35: North One-half of the Northeast Quarter and Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (N/2 NE/4 and NE/4 NW/4)

B. POOL DEFINITION:

1.1 The South Wolf Creek Field Smackover Oil Pool in the South Wolf Creek Field should be construed to mean those strata of the Smackover Formation production of oil and other hydrocarbons occurring between the electric log depths of 15,400 feet and 15,600 feet on the electric log of the Sandefer Oil & Gas, Inc.-David Brenner Well No. 1, said well being located at a point described as commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 26, Township 10 North, Range 8 West, Wayne County, Mississippi, go South 81° 47' W 1,279 feet, thence go North 08° 13' W 795 feet, and all sands correlative and in communication with those strata and which are productive of oil and other hydrocarbons.

C. RULES:

RULE 1 - SPACING OF WELLS:

1.1 As to each well drilled to and productive from the South Wolf Creek Field Smackover Oil Pool:

- (a) Shall be located on a drilling unit consisting of eighty (80) contiguous surface acres, or the equivalent of two (2) governmental quarter-quarter sections containing not less than seventy-two (72) acres or more than eighty-eight (88) acres, upon which no other drilling or producible well is located;

(b) Any drilling unit not composed of two (2) governmental quarter-quarter sections must be completely encompassed by the perimeter of a rectangle 1,600 feet by 2,725 feet. Provided, however, no unit shall be permitted which will create island acreage;

(c) The well shall be located at least 1,000 feet from every other drilling well or well completed in or producing from the same pool located in conformity with this rule; and

(d) The well shall be located at least 500 feet from every exterior boundary of the drilling unit.

RULE 2 - EFFECTIVE DATE:

2.1 These rules shall be effective on October 15, 1986.


RULE 3 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:

3.1 All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendment thereto, not specifically covered by the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to the field.

3.2 The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any or all of the foregoing Special Field Rules, or to grant exceptions to all or any part thereof.
